CONFLICTS

We would like to accommodate each and every conflict but that will more than likely be impossible and you may have to make a choice. The running order for classes will be posted at each ring, each day. If you have a conflict, please ask the blind steward to put a "C" by your name. If you are not in at the ring when your blind is called, we will fill your space with someone that is present. When you are available to run, please check in and we will assign you to a new blind. We cannot guarantee you will run immediately upon checking in.

We will not hold a class if you are not present by the time the class ends, you will not be able to run your dog in that class for that trial. There are two trials each day but a missed run in trial one cannot be run in trial two.

We will verify all conflicts with the judging program of other events.

Building Hours: Cox Pavilion building will be open to exhibitors Thursday at 2pm and will close at 7pm. Friday through Sunday the building will be open at 0630am and close 7pm daily. No dogs may be left in the Cox Pavilion overnight.

General Information and Policies

It is the responsibility of each competitor to read and understand the current Barn Hunt Association, LLC (BHA) Rules prior to participating in this event. http://www.barnhunt.com/rules/barnhunt_competitorrules_2019.pdf

Possessing or training with personal tubes and/or live rats is NOT permitted on the event grounds at any time.

Barn Hunt Grounds: These trials are a part of the AKC Canine Summer Olympics and other associated events. Barn Hunt rules apply to any activities held in the Cox Pavilion. The grounds, all other buildings, parking, that surround the Cox Pavilion will be subject to AKC rules. There will be a potty area that is designated for BHA/AKC competitors and they must pick up after their dogs on the trial grounds and at the hotel.

Blinds: Instinct thru Senior classes will be blinds of 5, Masters will be blinds of 4.

Leashes and collars: See BHA Rulebook page 20 for specific information on what is allowed. Dogs cannot be brought to the ring on flexi-leads or prong collars.

Dog aggression: Any dog behaving in a threatening or aggressive manner toward another dog or person may be dismissed from the event if justification is found by the judge and/or Event Committee. Entry fees will not be refunded.

Bitches in season: Are eligible for entry but will be required to be kept separate from all other dogs and will run at the end of their class. They must wear pants at all times (including on course) while not being pottied. They must be pottied in an area away from the other dogs. Entry fees for bitches that come into season will be refunded until the closing date of October 20th, 2020 if you wish to withdraw. **The trial secretary must be notified prior to or upon arrival. Failure to do so may result in a disqualification and dismissal from the event.**

Videotaping and photography: Is allowed and encouraged! Videotaping by individuals for their own personal use will be allowed outside show rings only. The show committee reserves the right to regulate placement of cameras to prevent interference with traffic flow and exhibiting of dogs.

Volunteers: Are appreciated and needed!

Spectators: Spectators are welcome but must adhere to the Code of Good Sportsmanship outlined in the BHA Official Rulebook.

Sportsmanship: All competitors/handlers and spectators are expected to follow the rules of the BHA and demonstrate good sportsmanship. Please do not discuss hide placement or any details of a dog's performance that may provide information or clues to other handlers or may be overheard. Please be cognizant of teams competing in the ring and avoid loud or disruptive distractions.

Crating: Dogs must be leashed or crated when not actively working, and never tied out/left attached to anything other than a human. Crating space available inside, on grounds or in vehicles. Dogs may not be left in shared common crating area in Cox Pavilion overnight. Dogs left by agents or owners in Bennet Event center grooming area overnight are requested to identify the dog's crate with an emergency phone number or information in case of an emergency. AKC crating policy will apply.

Awards: Qualifying ribbons will be awarded for all qualifiers in the classes, including Instinct. Flat ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 4th place in Novice A, Open A, Senior A, Master A classes in each height division and 1st through 4th in B classes (all heights included together). High in Class rosettes will be awarded to fastest qualifying run in each class, excluding Instinct, for A and B classes. Special Champion High in Class (9 x 18, 5 Streamer) rosette and RHIC Champion (7 x 16, 3 Streamer) will be awarded. New Title rosettes, RATCH rosettes, Crazy 8 (Gold, Silver Bronze) medals will be available at event. Awards are self service and can be picked up from the secretary table. You will need to notify secretary (sheet at table) of new titles.

Non-Standard Awards: Crazy 8's overall champion will be awarded an embroidered director chair and rosette. Winner will have the highest score from the event (5 Crazy 8 classes, do not need to compete in all 5 trials to be eligible). First tie breaker will be fastest time followed by reverse highest score by trial. Additional special prizes may be awarded at the discretion of show committee.

Payment and entry information: Entries will NOT be accepted without signatures and payment. Entries are invalid without a signed Release Agreement Form. Owners are responsible for entry errors. Please write clearly and proof your entry. BHA will not make corrections once results are submitted. Incomplete forms and returned checks are invalid entries.

There is a \$35.00 fee for all returned checks. Entries accepted on a first come/first served basis.

Refunds are ONLY allowed if requested before the closing date of October 20, 2020

No event fee will be refunded if the event cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the event committee. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.

BHA registration number IS required! You can register your dog on line at <http://www.barnhunt.com>. BHA registration fee is \$30, and is a lifetime fee for that dog. There are no annual fees with BHA, and no membership fees for dog owners.
